The 339th Infantry Division served in the Loire Valley in France from May to August 1941. In September, it moved to Army Group Center (Rear) to take over security operations from another division. The 691st Infantry Regiment was headquartered in Berezino; its first battalion, under Major Commichau, was headquartered in Krugloye.
