National Days of Remembrance

PROCLAMATIONS FOR GOVERNORS

The reading of an official proclamation from a mayor or governor may be included in a Days of Remembrance commemoration. A request, along with this sample proclamation, should be sent to the governor's office several weeks before the observance. Inviting the mayor to the commemoration is also appropriate.

The language suggested here is based on messages and proclamations sent to the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum's Days of Remembrance program by public officials. Actual wording is the prerogative of the official who issues the document.
